



TERMS & CONDITIONS

Payment – Payment must be made before the start of each term, failure to pay will result in not being permitted to attend class.

Classes – Access to some aerial classes is restricted due to the level of skill needed. In such classes approval needs to be given by the instructor in the previously attended class. The beginner class is an introduction to aerial arts and builds up base strength and skills needed in the higher-level classes. This is a general class using a variety of aerial apparatus, such as the Lyre, Bungee loop, Silks/Tissue, Trapeze and much more. The Burlesque class is taught by a world famous burlesque artist, teaching skills from Fan dancing, Burlesque acro-balance, Giant champagne glass skills, character, costuming, and makeup. This class is available to all levels. The Intermediate class is a general Aerial class using the same variety of equipment as in the beginner class but with more advanced tricks, positions and moves. This class also has additional height to the equipment, for this class the student will need to be approved by ArtBabes. The All-level class has been made to accommodate all levels but still provides adequate training for more advanced students plus the added spotter training. It is important to always listen to the instructor in each class and follow instructions correctly to ensure the best and safest training.

Membership Fee – Becoming an ArtBabes member will give students access to the Aerial studio, equipment, costumes, props as well as access to the range of classes available, and to the skills and knowledge of the instructors. Membership fees are non negotiable and need to be paid at the beginning of each year before the first class. Failure to pay membership fee will result in higher-class fees as the student will not be a member and not have access to the benefits of membership. The membership fee can be paid late but it will incur an additional administration charge. Membership expires after the final class of each year.

Extra Classes – If a student wants to do more classes during the term, they are able to drop in on other classes (be advised that you'll need to contact ArtBabes to be sure the classes aren't fully booked) this will cost \$25 per class that you drop in on. Not all students will be able to do this; you will need to be approved by ArtBabes before dropping in to classes. On Sundays is 1pm-5pm training, to do this class you will also have to get approval from ArtBabes. ArtBabes has the right to cancel Sundays training if a Workshop is to be booked or if the time is needed to train for an upcoming performance, normal classes will not be affected if a performance is scheduled, although private class availability might be effected.

Discounts/ missed Classes/ catch up classes –if a student is unable to make a class or a class is missed, notice needs to be given 24hrs before said class and a catch up class can be arranged; otherwise the class will be forfeit. If a student is ejected from class for rude, unruly or disturbing behaviour no refund or catch up will be given. If a catch up class cannot be made during the usual class times, the catch up class can roll over into the next term. Catch up classes are valid for a term within that year. If a private class is unable to be attended and notice has been given; it can be carried through to the next term.

Refunds – A full refund will be given if you cancel your classes at least a week before start of term, minus \$30 administration fee. Failure to cancel classes before such time will result in the student not having access to full refund, each week the percentage available to the student will decrease by 30%. Payment can also carry forward for the next term instead if desired, although if student has already participated in some classes of the cancelled term transferring payment is subject to the cost of the attended classes. For private classes, notice needs to be given at least 24hrs in advance otherwise no refund will be given. In the unlikely event that a student is banned from classes due to poor behaviour, they will not be entitled to a full refund, depending on how far along the term is the refund shall be deducted 50% of the remaining classes.

Conduct –Appropriate clothing is to be worn by students to every class, and during said classes jewellery is not to be worn. All students should bring a sweat towel and drink bottle to every class. Shoes are not allowed to be worn in training area and never to be worn on equipment. Food is not allowed in studio and you are asked to take with you all rubbish left behind. Students are to arrive at least 5 minutes before class starts; instructors hold the right to refuse entry to late students and to eject unruly students. All students need to participate in every class warm-up otherwise no training will be given until such time that they have completed the warm up. Students need to know what they are capable of and not push themselves to hard, if your not sure on a particular move or trick ask the instructor and only do what your comfortable doing. No skylarking is to be permitted; these classes are to learn Aerial arts, dance, burlesque etc not to show off; which can result in endangering others and themselves. Students shall treat all equipment, costumes, and props in the appropriate manner. No student will touch any of the equipment until the instructor says so. Students are responsible for the cleaning of the training space and the storage of equipment prior to and after a class. Under no circumstance is a student to touch any of the rigging or rigging accessories. Inappropriate behaviour against another student or the instructor will not be tolerated. Failure to follow proper conduct will result in the student being ejected from class and possibly banned depending on severity.

Training level – As aerial arts has some danger involved it is important for students to respect the level that they are in as advancing before your ready could be harmful, and as such the instructors have final say in the progression of students.
